# Networking Luncheon A Hit 3

The Henderson-Vance Chamber of Commerce Membership Committee hosted a member/potential member networking lunch at noon on Thursday, October 13 at Henderson Country Club. This first-of-its-kind quarterly event boasted over 40 in attendance. The sponsor for the event was Henderson Wellness Center and Dr. Brandon Taylor. Dr. Taylor gave a brief description of his business and what types of services he and his staff offer.

This new event was created to offer members and potential new members the opportunity to network and make new contacts for their businesses as well as to offer an informative topic of interest to the business community.

At this event, a brief informative session was given on the upcoming December 1 Labor Law changes regarding overtime pay. Beginning on December 1, 2016, about 4.2 million more Americans will qualify for overtime pay under new rules from the U.S. Department of Labor. Under this new rule announced by the White House, anyone making less than \$47,476/year (\$913 a week) will automatically qualify for overtime pay when they work more than 40 hours a week. Hourly workers, lower-wage earners, non-managerial workers and many salaried workers must be paid 1.5 times their hourly wage when they work more than 40 hours in a week. Because the new overtime rules will impact many nonprofit and small business owners' budgets, the Chamber hosted Christine Ryan, Administrator, Wage and Hour Bureau - NC Department of Labor to discuss the ins and outs of the new regulation, the impact it could have on your business, your options, and resources for information. Ryan also provided information about the most common errors made by employers.

These events will be held quarterly making the next luncheon date to be Thursday, January 12th with others to follow in April, July and October of 2017. Cost for the events is \$20 per person for members and \$25 per person for non-members and includes a plated lunch, the keynote address and the opportunity to network with other small businesses.
